





# Data Needed to Classify

- Name and limits of roadway
- Number of through lanes
- Traffic
  - Traffic count
  - Date of count
  - Source of the Count

# Process

- Staff will package the request together
- Regional Council to approve the requests and submit to ADOT
- ADOT will review and forward to FHWA for approval
- FHWA will approve changes
