

Arizona's Export Economy

\$21 Billion

Total Value of Arizona's Exports in 2017

Since 2010, commodities exported from Arizona have increased 33%. In 2017 Arizona had \$21 billion in exports keeping it among the top 25 states for total export value. Of the \$21 billion in exports, 73% were exports to Arizona's top 10 trading partners. And with a combined total of close to \$10 billion in exports for 2017, Mexico and Canada continue to be Arizona's top trading partners.

Rank in Value of Export Commodities: 2010 to 2017





Jobs supported by Arizona goods exports grew 26% from 2010 to 2016


Manufacturing Growth

Export jobs in manufacturing grew 17% from 2010 to 2016



Arizona's Foreign Trade Balance


In 2017 Arizona had a trade balance surplus of \$370 million, with \$20.9 billion in exports and \$20.5 billion in imports.



Arizona's Trade as a Percent of GDP





(Billions of Dollars)




Out of 385 metropolitan areas in the U.S., the Phoenix MSA's ranking for total exports rose to 23rd in 2017, up from 29th in 2010.



Percent of Arizona exports from the Phoenix MSA




Percent of Phoenix MSA exports to Free Trade Agreement markets


Top 5 Countries Phoenix MSA Exported to in 2017
