- II. Discussion of comments from John Shi with MCDOT on Section 702 referencing recycled materials:

“The reason has been the concerns (for using recycled material greater than 50%) is the uniform consistency of the original recycled source, uniform in blending, and inconsistent proctors. All of the above may cause higher probability for an inconsistent supporting base course, on which the final AC pavement structure will be constructed.

The inconsistent property of the blended, recycled material may also cause difficulties in QA/QC testing (due to) highly variable proctor values.”

MCDOT only allows the use of recycled RAP and RCM on collector and local streets. If the recycled percentage limits are removed, MCDOT may further restrict the use of RAP and RCM for base course material.

If there is testing criteria to assure uniform blending and consistent proctors for the in-place recycled material, then MCDOT could support this case.”
