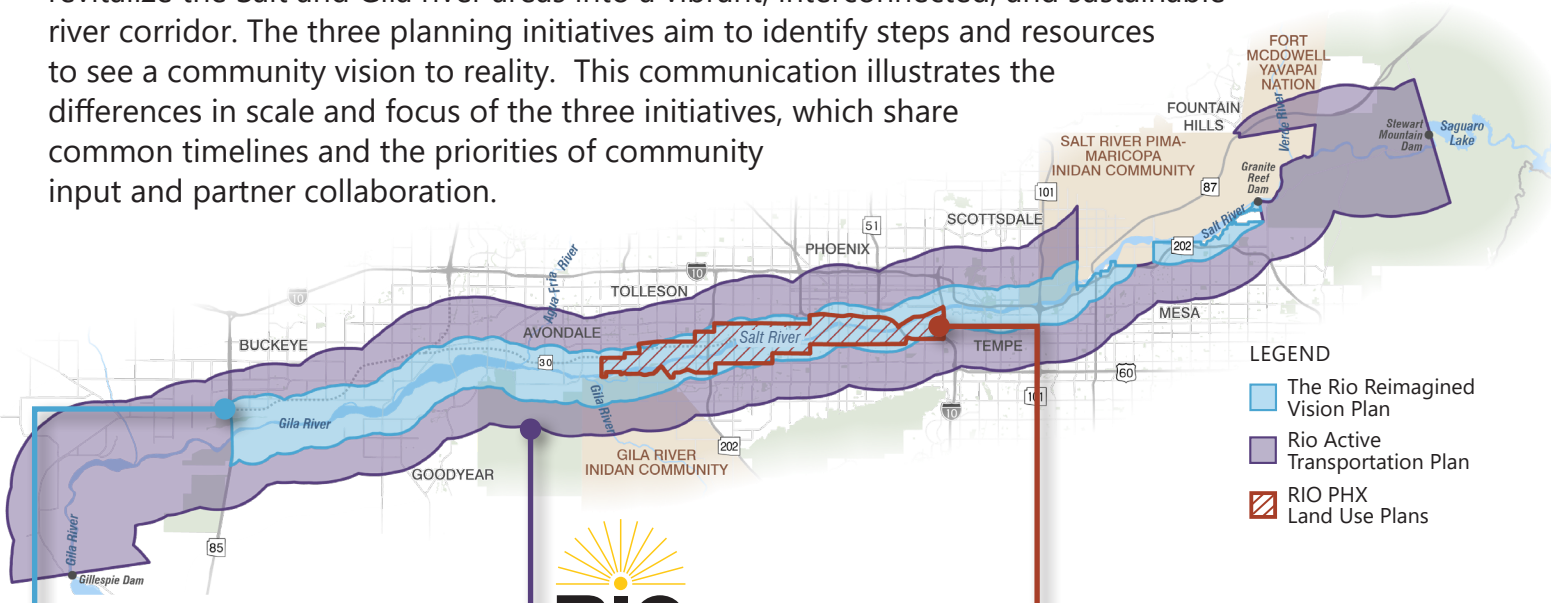


# The Rio Reimagined: Collaborative Planning Efforts

### The Rio Reimagined Vision Plan

**LENGTH:** 55 miles  
**LEAD:** Arizona State University (ASU)/Maricopa Association of Governments (MAG)/Greater Phoenix Leadership (GPL)

The plan will provide the **overall vision for the corridor**. It will balance community input, environmental needs, and development priorities with funding strategies to ensure a cohesive regional impact.

### Rio Reimagined Active Transportation Plan

**LENGTH:** 90 miles  
**LEAD:** MAG

The plan is dedicated to identifying a **connected regional trail** alignment along the river corridor. It will promote safe and effective active transportation by establishing vital bicycle and pedestrian links to neighboring communities and identifying essential non-motorized infrastructure enhancements.

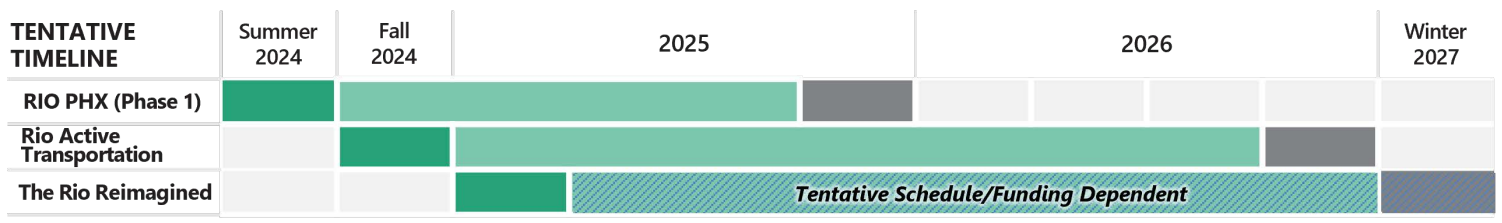
### RIO PHX

**LENGTH:** 20 miles  
**LEAD:** City of Phoenix

RIO PHX is a multi-phase initiative to create a series of land use policy plans that identify the **community's vision for the 20-mile corridor within the City of Phoenix**, including strategies for how to implement that vision. Topics for subarea plans may include housing, employment, recreation, art, health, and ecological restoration.
